What Happens When Your RHINOPLASTY FAILS?

■ IF YOU'VE HAD A RHINOPLASTY THAT DID NOT TURN OUT AS EXPECTED, THERE IS HOPE AND GOOD NEWS.

A failed rhinoplasty can be fixed by a skilled surgeon who has had special training in this field. Even with the best surgeons, 3-10% of rhinoplasties need minor revisions one year or later. It's just the nature of the variability of each individual's healing. It may be necessary, however, to have "major" revision rhinoplasty because the first surgeon "over did" the initial rhinoplasty or failed to correct the initial deformity. Revisions, known as "secondary" rhinoplasty, are very challenging and more difficult than the first, so you need to choose someone who per-

forms rhinoplasty on a regular basis with good outcomes and is current in their techniques. The original rhinoplasty surgeon may or may not be experienced enough to perform the required revision. Typically, the second surgery takes longer, is more work and is more expensive. It also usually takes somewhat longer to appreciate the result. Also remember, in order to avoid the need for an expensive revision, it's very important not to "price shop" for a "bargain" on your first rhinoplasty. People who are unhappy with their initial result must be patient and allow time for the healing process to complete before undergoing a revision. This usually takes about one year. Dr. Perkins is often called upon to perform these revision surgeries by patients and their referring rhinoplasty surgeons who are not as experienced as he is in correcting revision rhinoplasty problems. ■
